Certified by Lloyd's Register, CASA Chail features tank capacities of 26.6 m3 for fuel oil, 22.7 m3 for fresh water, and 6 m3 for chemicals, catering to extended maritime operations.

With a spacious deck layout, including a HIAB 022T-2 crane and HYPAC HHAW1516 anchor winch, CASA Chail is well-equipped for diverse marine tasks. Powered by twin CAT C32 engines, it reaches speeds of up to 20 knots, supported by a Side Power SP550 bow thruster for maneuverability.

Accommodating up to 50 individuals, CASA Chail offers comfortable amenities, including 8 bunks across 4 cabins and seating for 36 passengers on deck. Equipped with comprehensive radio communication and navigation systems, such as VHF/DSC radio, AIS, SART, EPIRB, radar, compasses, and GPS, CASA Chail ensures safe navigation in various sea conditions.



#### CASA DAGSHAI

Built in 2012, it holds a robust classification of MECAL, MCA Cat 3, adhering to top industry standards. Measuring 8.0 meters LOA, 3.35 meters beam, and 1.2 meters draft, it accommodates up to 10 passengers comfortably. With an approximate tonnage of 4.5 GRT, it's sturdy and seaworthy.

Powered by a Volvo D6 engine, derated to 240hp for efficiency, it achieves 3.5 knots survey speed and cruising speed of 10 to 12 knots. Equipped with a 5kW electrical generator and 350-liter fuel capacity, ensuring uninterrupted operations.

Navigation systems feature Garmin radar, chart plotter, echo sounder, VHF, and AIS, while communication includes iCOM IC-M411 VHF and Ooredoo 4G. Safety features 10 life jackets, emergency radios, fire extinguishers, and pyrotechnic signaling devices for passenger and crew well-being.
